

The Rule Book
of the project “The Yidan Prize“
in cooperation with the Association for the Promotion of Entrepreneurship

This rule book is directed to all participants and fellow workers on the project as a sum of the aims, its purpose, conditions for the participation in the competition, way of the application of the candidates, way of the selection of the best ones and the criteria for their selection, work of the selection board, awards and other issues.

Article 1
The aim of the project

The Yidan Prize is a competition which was founded in 2016 by Dr Charles Chen Yidan. The aim of the Yidan Prize is to create a better world through education and it consists of two awards:

1. Yidan Prize for Education Research and
2. Yidan Prize for Education Development

The Association “Živojin Mišić“ became a national partner of the Yidan Prize in Serbia at the end of the year 2018. Therefore the Association has become an organization which has the right to nominate the best teachers of Serbia for this competition via the project “The Best Educators of Serbia“. “The Best Educators of Serbia“ is a project which is a pre-qualification for Yidan Prize.

Our aim is to make it possible for the best teachers in Serbia to become known even on the world education stage and have the possibility of the exchange of good teaching practices with the best teachers of the world.

Article 2
The right to the competition for “The Yidan Prize“

All teachers in primary and secondary schools who are the winners of the award “The Best Educators of Serbia“, and who actively work in teaching and intend to work in teaching for at least five years, have the right to the competition for “The Yidan Prize“.

The right to the competition “The Yidan Prize“ is given to all the winners of the awards “The Best Educators of Serbia“, who think that they have made a significant contribution to:

- Education research
- Education development

“The Best Educators of Serbia“ are the teachers who have passed a serious selection at the level of their country and thereby qualified for the application and for the Yidan Prize.

Article 3

The way of applying

The candidates which bear the title "The Best Educators of Serbia" and think that they fulfill the criteria stated in Article 4 can apply for the award "Yidan Prize" via the form which they are given by the Association "Živojin Mišić" and which is in accordance with the form given by the "Yidan" Foundation.

Application forms are filled in Serbian and the Association "Živojin Mišić", according to the criteria of "The Yidan Prize", will translate up to five best application forms and enter the candidates for the competition "The Yidan Prize".

Article 4

The criteria

The nomination of each candidate which arrives is viewed according to the previously set criteria. There are four criteria which "The Yidan Prize" takes into account in the field of research and development in education and these are:

- The sustainability of results
- Oriented toward the future
- Innovativeness
- Possible transformations

Article 5

Time frame

The application forms for the competition for "The Yidan Prize" last until the end of March 2019. From April to September, the Yidan Prize board selects the candidates. In September 2019 the winners of the Yidan Prize competition will be announced on the website www.yidanprize.org. In December 2019 the award presentation ceremony will be held in Asia.

Article 6

The awards

Every winner of the Yidan award (either an individual or a team consisting of up to three members) will be given a certificate, gold medal and HK \$30 million (about US \$3.9 million) of the award – one half is the award in cash and the other half can be used as a project fund in the period of three years.
